***Overview of Diabetes* Topic of March 16 Lunch & Learn at Masonicare at Newtown**

Newtown, CT, February 15, 2010 A free lunch and learn for the community entitled, **“Overview of Diabetes”** will be held on **Tuesday, March 16**, in the Lodge Room at Masonicare at Newtown. Almost everyone knows someone who has diabetes. An estimated 23.6 million people in the United States - 7.8 percent of the population - have diabetes, a serious, lifelong condition.
