## Community Service

An individual performing community service to meet church or school requirements should apply through the adult or junior volunteer program.

### **Court-Ordered Community Service**

Masonicare Health Center will accept individuals 13 years or older with misdemeanors in the following areas:

- Traffic violations, such as failing to come to a stop at a stop sign, driving without insurance, speeding, parking tickets.
- Driving under the influence of alcohol
- Under age drinking of alcohol (we will not accept the person who gives underage individuals alcohol)
- Truancy

We will not accept individuals charged with the following:

- Theft of any kind, including shoplifting, larceny, embezzlement, robbery, etc.
- Violence of any kind, including assault, child abuse, battery, fighting
- Illegal drug charges
- Fraud
- Vandalism
- Sexual charges of any kind
- Any other felonies

The manager of Volunteer Services is under no obligation to accept an individual who seems to be unsuitable for a job at MHC. For those who are acceptable and for whom MHC has an opening, the community service volunteer must do the following:

- Provide written documentation from the courts or probation officer stating that they are required to complete court ordered community service, as well as the specifics of the offense
- Follow the process and requirements for adult or junior volunteers

The Volunteer Services manager and the community service volunteer will agree on a set schedule. If the volunteer is unable to come to volunteer on a scheduled date, it is the volunteer's obligation to provide advance notice. Failure to do so or repeated absences will result in dismissal of the volunteer.
