

Community Benefit 2024-2025



Masonicare is dedicated to improving the health of people living in the communities we serve.

Results of the 2023 survey conducted in the Greater Wallingford area indicate that Masonicare scored favorably in meeting the behavioral health needs of seniors. Survey highlights are available online and at the Masonicare Health Center. The 2023 survey will be available on our website and printed copies. Masonicare also is committed to providing the best quality care to residents and patients regardless of their ability to pay. In 2024-2025, our costs to cover traditional “charity care” and expenses associated with care not fully reimbursed by Medicaid, totaled **\$2,763,943**.



As a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization, Masonicare is also proud to provide free education programs, home visits and services, which include:



Masonicare's CareConnect Navigator is a complimentary personal resource dedicated to helping anyone in the community at large to navigate the complex world of health and senior care services.

The mission of this program is to help ease the stress of care transitions and assist in accessing care, services and resources. This year, we helped over **500 seniors**.



The Walk to End Alzheimer's: Masonicare employees join forces annually with the Alzheimer's Association of Connecticut to raise funds, raise awareness, and to support research and family care. In 2025, Masonicare's teams at the Greater New Haven, Central CT, Greater Hartford, New London Walk, Fairfield, and Mystic raised over **\$13,000** with **200** team members participating.



Masonicare held blood pressure screenings and participated at senior health fairs throughout the state. We have opened our facilities to many community organizations including Meriden-Wallingford M-Team, Healthy Wallingford, Parkinson's Support Groups, Veterans' Coffee Houses, The American Red Cross, CT Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, and the Alzheimer's Association. In all, Masonicare staff donated more than **916** hours of their time to benefit the community through seats on non-profit Boards, community events, support groups, and educational programs. These donated staff hours had a monetary value of over **\$65,090** and touched over **8,420** members of the community.

Over **700** surveys were sent out to social service workers, senior center directors, families of discharged behavioral health patients, seniors of Cheshire, Wallingford, Fairfield and North Haven, the Spanish Community of Wallingford (SCOW) and residents at Masonicare at Ashlar Village.
